

FinTrack: Family Vacation Budget

Mission: To transform vacation spending from a chaotic "credit card swipe" spree into a predictable, phased investment.

Phase 1: The Financial Charter (Definition of Done)

Rule: Define the Final Deliverable with Absolute Clarity. Stop vague budgeting. Define the "Hard Cap" before a single dollar is spent.

The "Definition of Affordable"	<i>Example: "A 7-day trip to Disney World for 4 people, staying on-property, strictly under \$6,000 total."</i>
Dates of Travel	Start: YYYY-MM-DD

Phase 2: Master Asset Acquisition (Pre-Trip Booking)

Rule: Deconstruct Development into Linear Steps. Consolidated view of all fixed costs incurred BEFORE departure.
